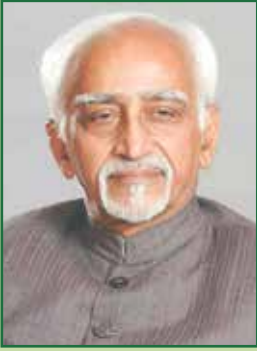

# About the Institute

Chandragupt Institute of Management Patna (CIMP) has been established as an autonomous institution with active support from the Government of Bihar. The institute was founded with an objective of contributing substantially to the academic and development credentials of Bihar, while fulfilling the primary role of training students to become professional managers. CIMP offers a two-year full-time, AICTE approved Post Graduate Diploma in Management. The institute follows, to the extent possible, all practices, systems and processes of leading management institutes. In a short period of four years, CIMP has proved its worth to the corporate world and has been able to achieve 100% placement for all the three batches (2008-10 First Batch, 2009-11 Second Batch and 2010-12 Third Batch) in various companies of national and international repute.

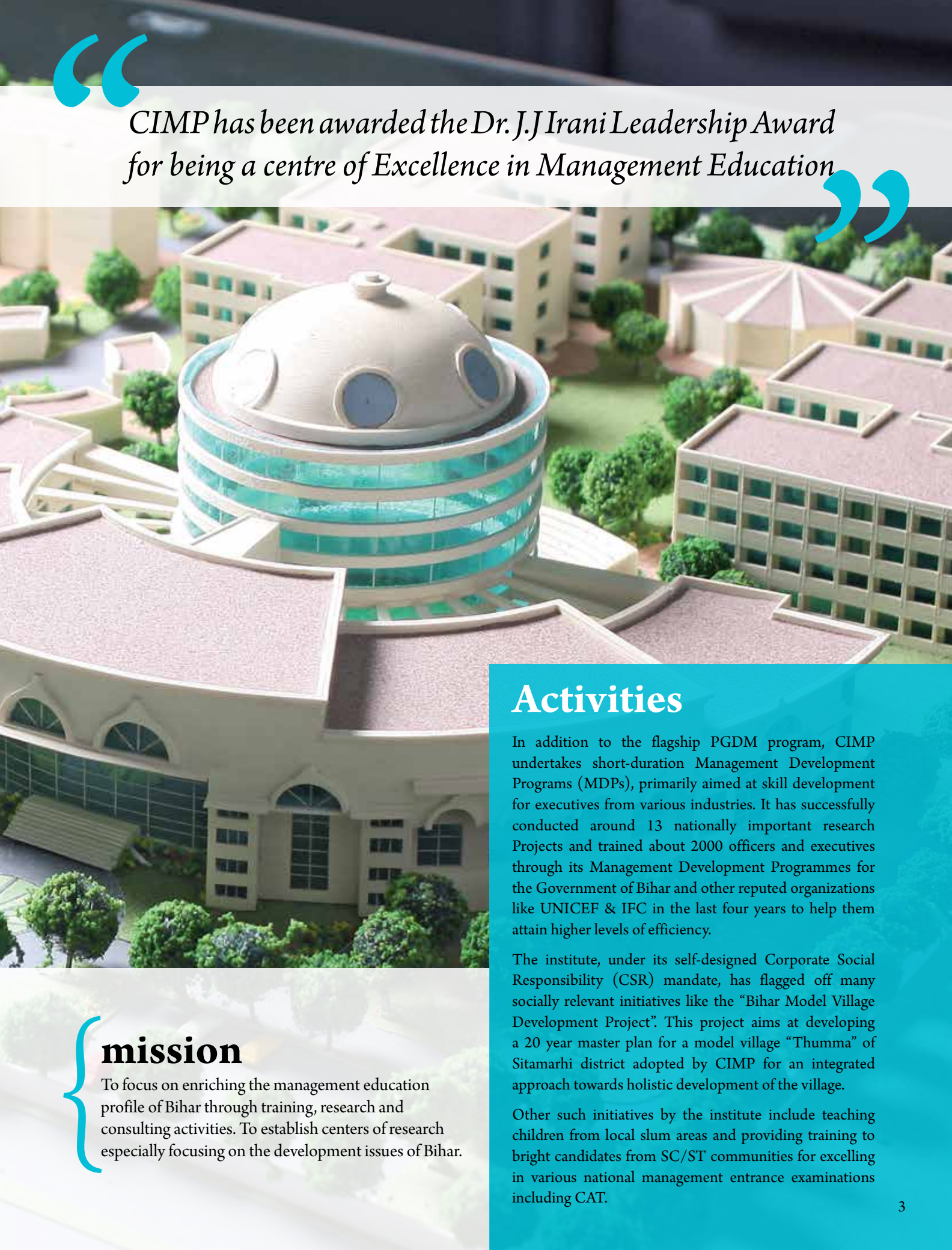
CIMP firmly believes that the process of learning and knowledge should not be restricted to the four walls of management institute. Hence CIMP is deeply involved in research transfer with top B-schools like Lancashire Business School, Stockholm Business School and draws teaching materials from Harvard Business publishing (a unit of Harvard Business School). It has been declared the first stand-alone Educational Institute in the country to submit successfully all required information to All India Survey on Higher Education (AISHE), Statistics Division, Department of Higher Education, MHRD, New Delhi. It has organized more than 10 National and 3 International Seminars/Conferences across the country and many eminent personalities from various sectors have visited the institute and interacted with students to share their knowledge and experience.

## **mission**

## **Activities**

In addition to the flagship PGDM program, CIMP undertakes short-duration Management Development Programs (MDPs), primarily aimed at skill development for executives from various industries. It has successfully conducted around 13 nationally important research Projects and trained about 2000 officers and executives through its Management Development Programmes for the Government of Bihar and other reputed organizations like UNICEF & IFC in the last four years to help them attain higher levels of efficiency.

The institute, under its self-designed Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) mandate, has flagged off many socially relevant initiatives like the “Bihar Model Village Development Project”. This project aims at developing a 20 year master plan for a model village “Thumma” of Sitamarhi district adopted by CIMP for an integrated approach towards holistic development of the village.

Other such initiatives by the institute include teaching children from local slum areas and providing training to bright candidates from SC/ST communities for excelling in various national management entrance examinations including CAT.



## Infrastructure

Located in the heart of the city of Patna, the campus is entirely wi-fi enabled. All classrooms and conference rooms are air-conditioned and are equipped with LCD screens and projectors to stimulate learning and interaction. In addition to the classrooms, the institute has a library, an auditorium, a computer centre, faculty rooms and on-campus hostel facility for students. Institute also has a Badminton Court, Table Tennis Board and in-house Gym facilities.

### Library

The state-of-the-art Library Resource Centre (LRC) is at the heart of CIMP's teaching, learning, training and research activities. The library has the facility to access e-resources from Harvard Business Publishing, an independent unit of Harvard Business School and INDEST-AICTE Consortium, jointly established by the Ministry of Human Resource Development (MHRD) and IIT Delhi and Information and Library Network (INFLIBNET), Ahmedabad. The library stocks more than 15,000 books, 260 print journals, 138 newspapers (print and online), 600 government publications, 2000 Harvard classic collections, 500 handbooks and non-book materials, including 900 CDs received with books, 120 videos and 250 audio collections. Students can access more than 10,000 full text journal titles from databases such as EBSCO, ProQuest, JSTOR, Emerald Insight, and J-Gate. The library also subscribes to business data-bases such as PROWESS, Datamonitor 360, ISI Emerging Markets, IAS, Capitaline Plus and latest statistical software like AMOS, Clementine, Stata, Eviews and reference management software like EndNote. The Library offers user services such as Self Automated System, RFID, Document Delivery Service, WebOpac powered by VTLS, Bibliographic Service, Institutional Repository, Open Video Digital Library, Virtual Reference Service etc. The students have 24 hours access to the library; they can easily access the library online by sitting in their hostel rooms also.



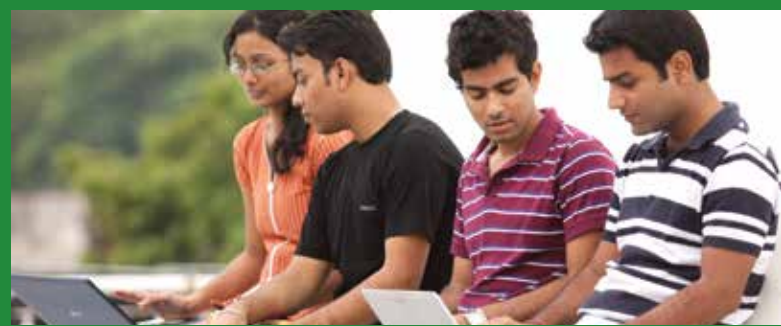
## Computing Facilities

Information Technology (IT) is an integral part of the success of any leading management institute. Therefore, IT and e-enablement at the campus is a critical component of CIMP's focus towards excellence. CIMP's strategy provides visibility of services and assets, control of information and systems and automation of tasks and processes. ## Auditorium

The 300-seater auditorium is the pride of CIMP. The hub of all co-curricular activities, the auditorium has hosted eminent personalities, including the Honorable Vice-President of India Prof. Mohd. Hamid Ansari, UID Chairman Mr. Nandan Nilekani, Musical Maestro Pandit Ulhas Kashalkar, Chairman, National Innovation Council Mr. Sam Pitroda and many others. All seminars, industry interface, cultural programmes and the Annual Convocation are held in the auditorium.



## New Campus

CIMP envisages moving to its new campus very soon. The Government of Bihar has allotted 20 acres of land to CIMP for building a state-of-the-art academic-cum-residential campus in Mithapur, which is 4 kms away from Patna airport and 1.5 kms away from Patna railway station. The construction of the new campus is already underway and is expected to be operational by early 2014.

CIMP is looking forward to start a post graduate programme in Agri-Business Management in the new campus. The new campus will also have an International Management Education Centre with outreach campuses in other countries, such as Fiji and Mauritius.

# Academic Program & Courses

The residential two-year full-time Post Graduate Diploma in Management prepares students for careers in various organisations. The program is designed to enhance the problem solving and decision making abilities of participants and create awareness on the socio-economic environment. The aim of the programme is to produce managers with socially desirable values.



During the first year of the programme, students learn basic concepts in the areas of Business Communication, Finance & Accounting, Marketing, Organizational Behaviour, Operations Management and Quantitative Techniques. These core courses help the students in building sound foundation in various functional areas. During second year, students get an opportunity to choose their specialization according to their areas of interest. Currently, two specializations viz. Finance & Marketing are offered in the second year. The students are exposed to at least 300 cases on a variety of organizations, different experiential techniques, and field studies apart from a two months summer internship in reputed organizations. The program ensures that students develop a healthy appreciation of both the theory and practice of business.

The curriculum also lays emphasis on courses and activities that sensitize the students to social, environmental and ethical issues.

Academic collaborations with universities in USA, Sweden and other countries are being initiated for student exchange programme and research activities.

# Admission Process

Eligible candidates appearing for CAT 2012 and desirous of admission to 2-year full-time Post Graduate Diploma in Management (PGDM) of the institute for the session 2013-15 are required to submit filled-in and duly signed application forms (enclosed with this Information Brochure) to the CIMP Admissions Office latest by **8th December 2012**.

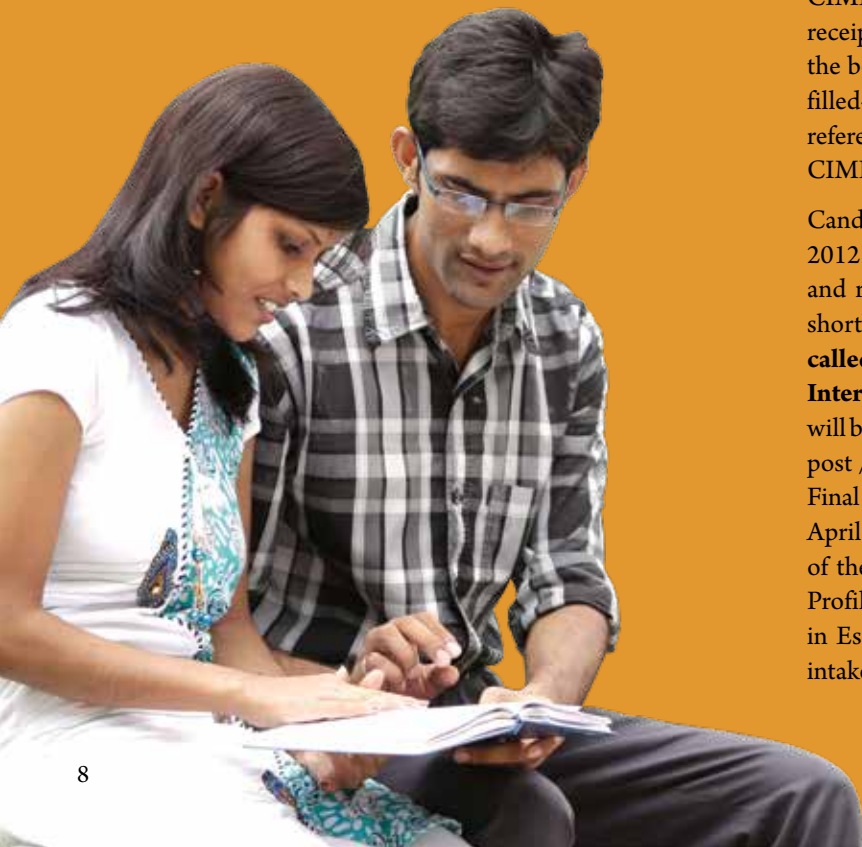


Application forms along with Information Brochure can be procured from CIMP between 10th September and 7th December 2012 by paying 1000/- (200/- for SC/ST candidates). Alternatively, eligible candidates can apply online ([www.cimp.ac.in](http://www.cimp.ac.in)) and send duly completed and signed printout of online application along with a Demand Draft of 1000/- (200/- for SC/ST candidates) in favor of Chandragupt Institute of Management Patna payable at Patna, to CIMP

Admissions Office. Eligible candidates can also download the Application Form and Information Brochure from the institute website ([www.cimp.ac.in](http://www.cimp.ac.in)) and send duly completed and signed application form along with the Demand Draft to CIMP Admissions Office. SC and ST candidates must enclose a copy of their SC/ST certificates along with the downloaded application form / printout of online application.

CIMP will not be responsible for any postal delays or for non-receipt of application forms due to any reasons. Hence it is in the best interest of the applicant to retain a photocopy of the filled-in application form and the Demand Draft for future reference. The applicant must check the application status on CIMP website or on his / her email regularly.

Candidates would be shortlisted on the basis of their CAT 2012 scores. Other criteria like previous academic record and relevant work experience will also be considered while shortlisting applicants. **Shortlisted candidates would be called to attend Essay Test, Group Discussion & Personal Interview during the month of March 2013.** Candidates will be informed about the GD / PI schedule by courier / speed post / registered post as well as by emails by 1st March, 2013. Final offer of admission would be declared in the 1st week of April 2013. The final merit list would be made on the basis of the weighted score in various components like Academic Profile, CAT 2012 score, Work Experience and performance in Essay Test, Group Discussion & Personal Interview. The intake for the 2013-15 session would be 60 students.



## Eligibility

The candidate must hold a Bachelor's degree, with atleast 50% marks or equivalent CGPA [45% in case of the candidates belonging to Scheduled Caste (SC), Scheduled Tribe (ST) and Differently Abled (DA) categories], awarded by any of the Universities incorporated by an Act of the central or state legislature in India or other educational institutions established by an Act of Parliament or declared to be deemed as a University under Section 3 of the UGC Act, 1956, or possess an equivalent qualification recognized by the Ministry of HRD, Government of India. Candidates appearing for the final year of Bachelor's degree/equivalent qualification examination and those who have completed degree requirements and are awaiting results can also apply. If selected, such candidates will be allowed to join the programme provisionally. The admission will be confirmed only if he/she submits a certificate latest by June 30, 2013 from the Principal/Registrar of his/her College/Institute (issued on or before June 30, 2013) stating that the candidate has completed all the requirements for obtaining the bachelor's degree/equivalent qualification on the date of the issue of certificate. **Prospective candidates must maintain a valid email account and consistent phone number throughout the selection process. CIMP will not be responsible for non-delivery of messages if the email address and phone number supplied in the application form are invalid/changed later.**

The candidates should follow the CAT advertisement of IIMs for procurement of CAT 2012 voucher. The last date for obtaining the CAT 2012 voucher is September 17, 2012.

Though CIMP uses CAT for short-listing the candidates for Post Graduate Programme in Management, IIMs have no role either in the selection process or in the conduct of the programme.

## Reservation

The institute follows reservation policy as prescribed by the Government of Bihar for educational institutions.

The reserved seats are as follows:

**General Category – 50%**

**SC – 16%, ST – 01%, EBC – 18%**

**BC – 12%, Women of BC – 3%**

Amongst all the categories, 50% of the total seats would be reserved for students who qualify as a Domicile of Bihar (permanent residents only) and 3% of the total seats for Persons with Disability (PWD).

## Fee Schedule

Total fee for the program would be approx. ₹5 Lakh inclusive of Mess charges, subject to revision in every academic year. Other than the fee, students need to spend on their own for their personal expenses. Laptops would be an integral tool for

# Life at CIMP

A lot of learning in a Business School happens outside the classrooms. At CIMP, life outside classrooms is full of activity, learning and enthusiasm. In a short span of time, CIMP students have organised several actively run groups and clubs in the campus. These initiatives have considerably increased balanced life for students in the two years of PGP at CIMP campus. These activities also help students inculcate a sense of teamwork, togetherness, leadership, and decision-making ability which are important takeaways of management education.



## Pravartana–The Management Club

As the name suggests, “Pravartana” or innovation is a club focused to engage the students in different management activities. It aims at honing creativity along with imbibing time management skills. This club conducts business quizzes, management games, interaction sessions under its banner. “Stay Active, Stay Ahead” is its motto. Pravartana organizes an annual festival called Gnosis Samaagam which receives participation from premier institutes.

## Academic Committee

The committee plays an important role in upholding and developing the academic standards at CIMP and assisting the faculty to keep the academic curriculum and pedagogy updated. It is an interface between the students and the PGP office which also helps students in academic matters by providing, inter alia, remedial classes, collating student’s feedback and helping students enhance their communication skills.

## Placement Committee

CIMP’s placement activities are coordinated by this committee comprising a faculty member as placement coordinator and some elected student representatives. This committee tries to match the requirements of the corporate world with the expectations of students by facilitating a smooth placement process. The committee also works closely with the industry to receive feedback on the institute’s curriculum and students’ competencies.

Organizing large scale events like inter college festivals provides hands-on event management experience to future managers. ## Rebel & change, Sam tells CIMP passouts

**PATNA:** National Innovation Council chairman Sam Pitroda chose apt words this leisurely Sunday to fire the imagination of passing out graduates of the Chandragupt Institute of Management Patna (CIMP). "Challenge the status quo and become the real agents of generational change", he told the budding management gurus.

Explaining the need, desire and reason for bringing about such a change, Pitroda said he was more often worried about the pace of change in the country which has 32 million pending court cases and takes 15 years to deliver justice.

"My other worry is that a lot of youths start talking like their parents rather too quickly," he said, exhorting the students present at the CIMP's third annual convocation to "rebel".

Taking a leaf out of his own life, Pitroda said living in a country where most of the processes were designed some 70 years back, the question one should ask was: What could be done?

"You can demand change, be a change agent and emit a strong will to get over personal interest and find happiness in matters of public interest. Though I prefer that all of you become job givers, even the ones going in the system" should chal-

lenger status quo or face the consequence of being rendered useless," he said. Assuring them that his journey so far had been exciting, he said education, being empowering and re-defining, had transformed him and his family. The

learning models needed to be changed to arm youths with the necessary tools to meet their aspirations. "No more are teachers required to create the content and delivery. Their role is going to change to that of a mentor,"

said the man credited with ushering the telecom revolution in the country. "The challenge, today, is to use the platform of one billion connected people to our advantage for doing things differently", he argued. The task of laying out a plan

for narrowing down the huge disparities, finding the right teachers, creating jobs, providing skills to 350 million youth below 25 years of age for meeting their aspirations and nation's desire for inclusive growth is massive.

"The country, including Bihar, will need a good amount of managerial talent to ensure new ways of doing things, as growth cannot be just for the people at top of the pyramid," he said.

"The problems of the poor often don't get the right kind of talent. This has rendered that task of making a dent in poverty difficult. Once the mindset was changed, new models with community involvement would start evolving for dealing with issues like garbage, traffic jams, water management.

"For ushering generational change, focus should be on innovation," Pitroda said expressing his happiness that the CIMP was starting an innovation centre.

Chief secretary Naveen Kumar said that the government was pleased with national level educational standards maintained by the institute and would like to scale up the number of student intake to 240 in the coming days. V Mukunda Das, director, in his welcome address, gave brief overview of the CIMP achievements.

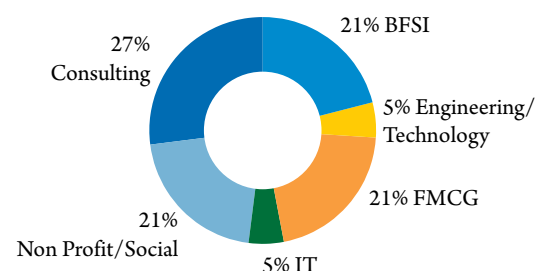

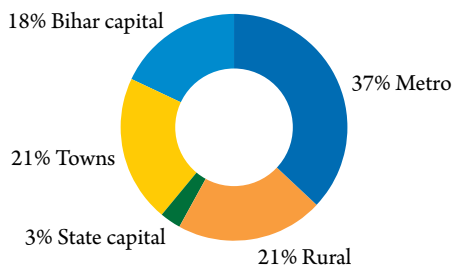

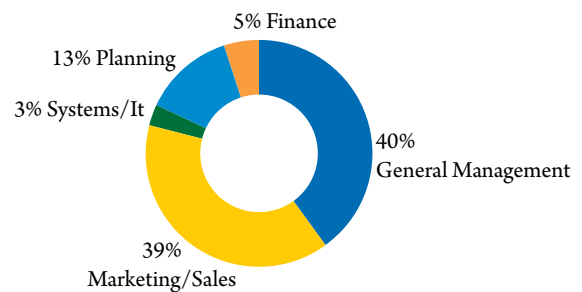

# Research & Consulting

CIMP faculty is engaged in cutting-edge research in the field of management. The recent publications and conference presentations bear testimony to the quality research produced by CIMP internal faculty team.

Faculty have presented their research papers at international conferences like INFORMS Marketing Science Conference in the US, Canada & Germany, Academy of Management Conference in the US, Green Economics Conference at Oxford University, UK and Global Conference on Academic Disciplines at Harvard University, US, to name a few.

The Sub-Centre proposes to help in building-up the database of MFIs in the country and prepare the road-map for Micro-Finance in Bihar.

The centre has initiated research in high priority areas of Microfinance in the context of Bihar, so that policy makers in Government and financial institutions will devise and

design appropriate managerial models. CIMP will help the development of new managerial concepts for overcoming organizational issues involved in Microfinance. This will increase the effectiveness of micro level organizations and their activities.

The institute has created history by achieving the milestones in research within the short span. The sub-centre will be helpful in giving boost to microfinance activities by bridging the critical gap, which is the need of the hour for the poverty stricken people of Eastern India.
