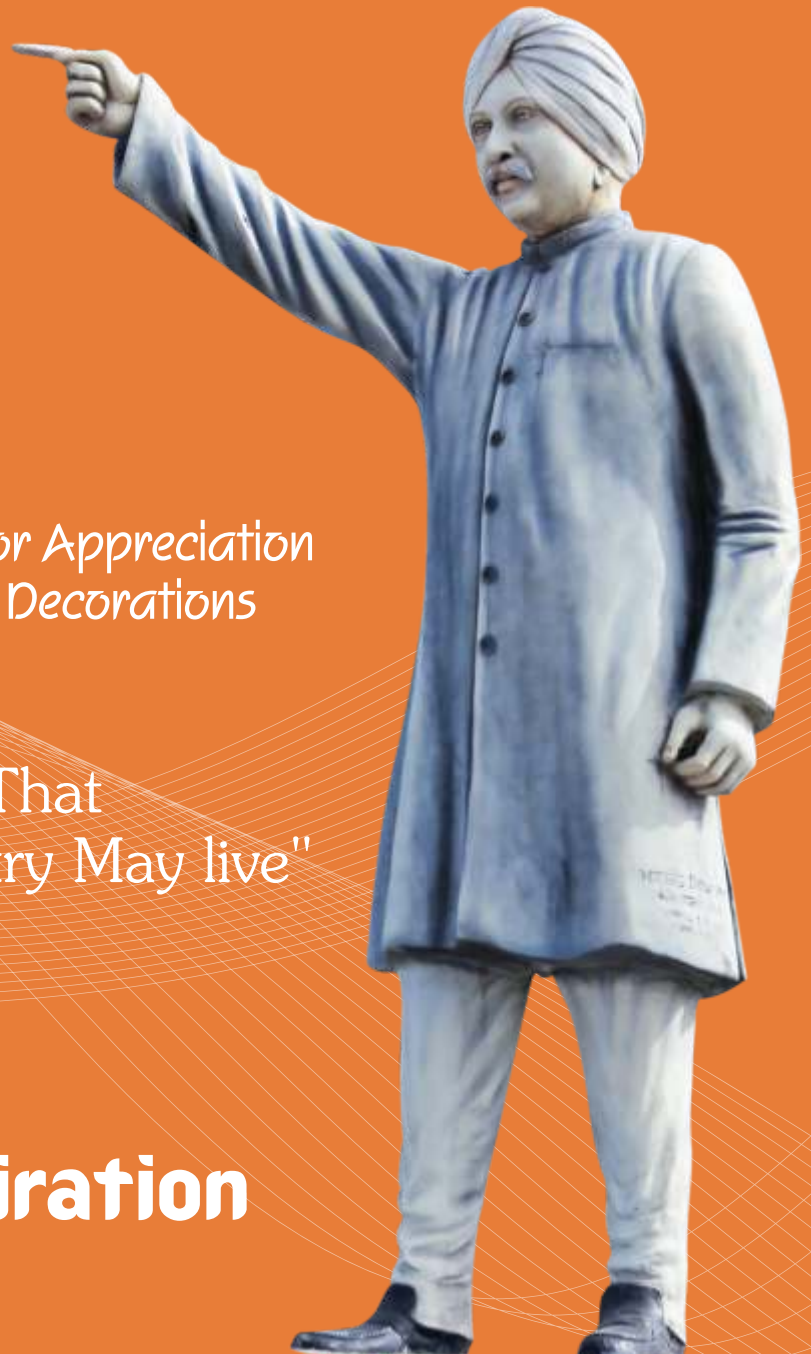

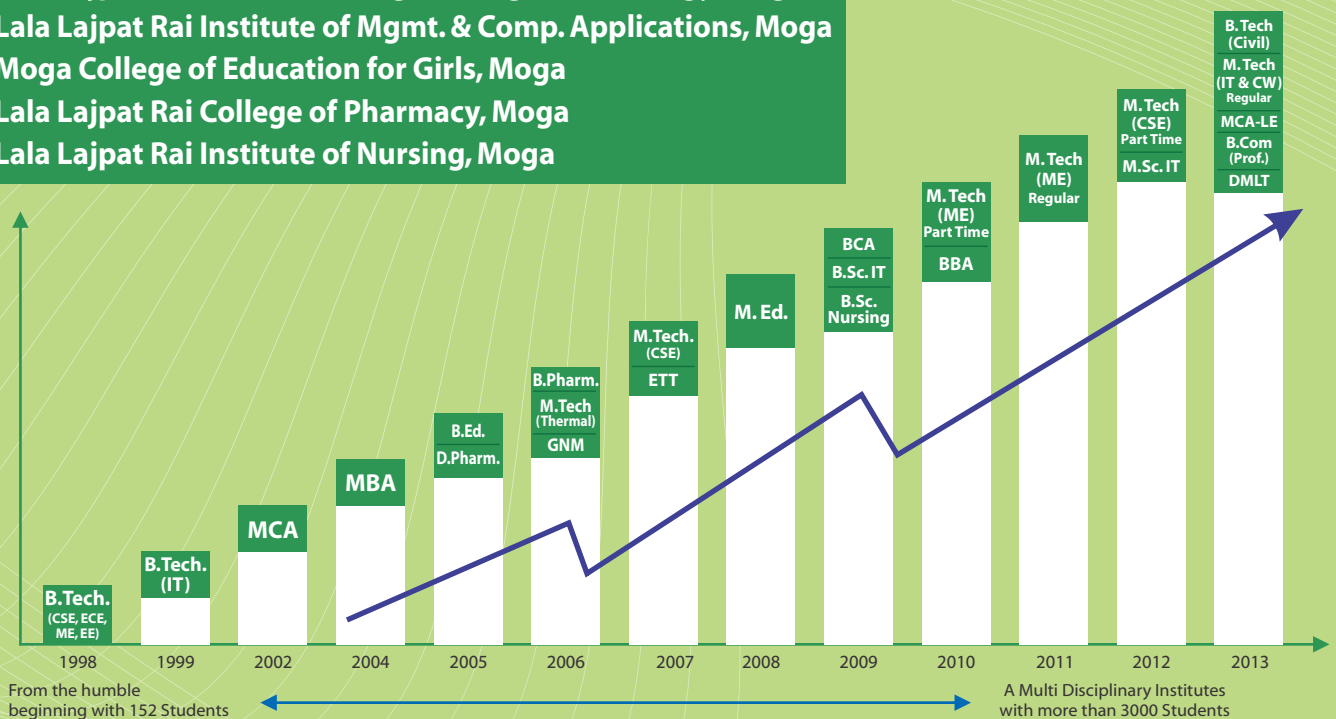

Provisions & Benefits of Global Collaborations

The students of LLRIET now have golden opportunity to get enrolled themselves for abroad study in U.K., USA & New Zealand Institutions and Universities and can get joint degree Internationally.

- Study of similar contents of prescribed courses will be studied in India and similar degree, diploma and certificate are to be studied in International partner Institutions.

- The Management of Lala Lajpat Rai Institute of Engineering & Technology, Moga (Pb.), looking forward and keeping in mind the Global Perspective in technical education, has setup International pathway for the Indian students to materialize the dream of obtaining foreign degree easily in LLRIET, Moga. To attain this objective the following provisions have been created in executing MOU with Wayne State University (UWS), Detroit, Michigan, U.S.A.
- WSU and LLRIET have agreed to collaborate and develop a joint MS degree program in Mechanical Engineering that will incorporate educational offerings at both WSU and LLRIET and have students spend their residency periods in both the United States and India.
- Students enrolled in this program will typically spend the first part of their study at LLRIET taking courses and continue to study at WSU for 20 additional credit hours and research. WSU will allow transfer of up to 12 credit hours from LLRIET in order to meet the degree requirements for the MS degree of WSU. A list of LLRIET courses that are transferable will be determined. Upon completion, the student will obtain a MSME degree from WSU.
- The undergraduate students in LLRIET can transfer to WSU. The credit hours earned by the undergraduate students at LLRIET can be transferred as per rules of WSU, they will complete credit hours as advised by the advisors of WSU. On completion of all the credit hours by WSU, they will get Wayne State Degree.
- If a research thesis component is chosen, the student will be co-advised by faculty members from both WSU and LLRIET. These faculty members will develop thesis topics of mutual interest.
- Graduate students currently enrolled in the Department of Mechanical Engineering at LLRIET are eligible to participate in this program. The Department of Mechanical Engineering at LLRIET will make an effort to recruit students to this program.
- The provision of joint educational program like degree program, joint research projects developments, exchange of faculty members in teaching and research in mechanical engineering has been made.

Eligibility Criteria

Under Graduate Degree Programs

Sr. Program	Duration	Eligibility
1. Engineering & Technology	4 Years	Passed 10+2 Examination with Physics and Mathematics as compulsory subjects along with one of the Chemistry/Biotechnology/Biology. Obtained at least 45% marks (40% marks in case of candidate belonging to reserved Category) in the above subjects taken together.
2. Engineering & Technology	Lateral Entry to Second Year	<p>A. Passed Diploma examination from an AICTE approved institution; with at least 45% marks (40% marks in case of candidates belonging to reserved category) in appropriate branch of Engineering/Technology</p> <p>B. Passed B.Sc Degree from a recognized University as defined by UGC, with at least 45% marks (40% marks in case of candidates belonging to reserved category) and passed XII standard with mathematics as a subject.</p> <p>C. Provided that in case of students belonging to B.Sc. Stream, shall clear the subjects of Engineering Graphics/ Engineering Drawing and Engineering Mechanics of the first year Engineering program along with the second year subjects.</p> <p>D. Provided further that, students belonging to B.Sc. Stream shall be considered only after filling the supernumerary seats in this category with students belonging to the Diploma stream.</p> <p>E. Provided further that students, who have passed Diploma in Engineering and Technology from an AICTE approved institution or B.Sc Degree from a recognized University as defined by UGC, shall also be eligible for admission to the first year Engineering Degree courses subject to vacancies in the first year class in case the vacancies at lateral entry are exhausted. 4. M.E / M.Tech	2 Years	Bachelor's Degree or equivalent in the relevant field. Obtained at least 50% marks (45% marks in case of candidate belonging to reserved Category) at the qualifying Examination.

Fee Structure

- Fee structure as prescribed by PTU/Govt. of Punjab will be applicable at the time of admission.
- Students availing hostel are required to pay the hostel charges at the time of admission.
- Transport charges are required to be paid at the time of admission.

Fee Waiver Scheme

Fee waiver scheme will be implemented in the institute as per latest Government notification intimated time to time.

Incentives in the form of Scholarships, Awards & Fee Concession

To encourage students for better performance in studies, sports & extra curricular activities, the following Scholarships, Academic Rewards and incentives for the academic year 2012-13 are provided by LLRIET, Moga.

1. Special Incentives for New Admission for B.Tech students

Based on JEE (Main) Rank

Rank in JEE (Main)	Tuition Fee Concession
1-1000	100% Tuition Fee Concession
1001-5000	50% Tuition Fee Concession
5001-10000	25% Tuition Fee Concession

The fee concession will be for one semester initially. This will continue provided the student obtains 80% marks in PTU Exams in subsequent semesters.

Based on 10+2 Marks

Percent Marks in 10+2	Scholarship per month
More than 90%	Rs. 1500/- P.M.
85% to 89.9%	Rs. 1000/- P.M.
80% to 84.9%	Rs. 500/- P.M.

The scholarship is for first semester initially. The scholarship will be continued provided the student maintains 80% marks in PTU exams in subsequent semesters.

2. Scholarship to final year students will be based on the position of student in PTU merit list. The students, who will come in first 3 position in PTU merit list, will be awarded the amount of 15000/- each and from 4th to 10th Position, 12000/- each.

- ❖ These scholarships are valid for both UG & PG classes. As per norms & conditions listed below.
- ❖ Scholarship and attendance incentive will be awarded for the subsequent semester based on performance in previous semester.
- ❖ Attendance will be considered based only on chalkpad data.
- ❖ Student must have minimum 75% attendance in all the subjects (i.e. theory, practical & including optional subjects, if any).
- ❖ The Student must have total aggregate marks of 75% upto the end of last semester.
- ❖ Student has cleared all the subjects in all the semesters in first attempt.
- ❖ The student has studied at least 4 theory subjects in the semester.
- ❖ No scholarship will be awarded in semester when students are on Industrial training/ other training.
- ❖ First year students and LEET students of 3rd Semester (who have been admitted late in the institute) are eligible only if they have attended at least 75% of the scheduled classes from start of semester.
- ❖ No attendance incentive shall be given to passing out students (i.e. in last final semester when classes are held)
- ❖ These scholarships and monetary incentives shall be given to those students only who will be present physically on the day of Award Distribution Function, unless prior written permission for not attending function under compelling circumstances is taken from college.
- ❖ Monetary incentive for attendance shall be given only if student has cleared all the courses in that semester.
- ❖ Student shall be eligible only for one scholarship/incentive at one time.
- ❖ The scholarship conditions can be varied/changed at the start of any new academic year without assigning any reason

3. Annual Awards For Academic Performance at Institute Levels (based On PTU Exams)

Topper of each branch year wise (who obtains highest marks in aggregate each year-both semesters) will be awarded of Rs.3100/- (without reappear in any of the semester).

2nd position in each branch year wise in aggregate each year-both semesters will be awarded a scholarship of Rs.2100/- (without reappear in any of the semester).

- All courses in all semesters are cleared in first attempt.
- Provided marks at the end of year are at least 80 percent in both semester.
- These annual awards will be given at the Annual Function of the Institute.

4. Award For Academic Performance In PTU Exams at The End of Final Year.

Students obtaining 1st, 2nd & 3rd positions at PTU level in their respective branches (overall aggregate of 4 years) will be awarded Rs.31000/-, Rs.21000/- & Rs.11000/- respectively. Students obtaining 4th to 10th positions at PTU level in their respective branches (overall aggregate of 4 years) will be awarded Rs.3100/- each.

5. 10% Tuition fee concession (for full course): Brother/Sister of the student studying in the Institute.

6. 10% Tuition fee concession (for full course): Wards of Defence Personnel killed in action.

7. Awards For Excellence In Sports And Extra Curricular Activities At PTU Level

- Students representing PTU in Inter-University Youth Festival in Extra Curricular Activities will be awarded cash prize of Rs.5100/- each.
- Students winning "Best Athlete Trophy" in the Inter Engineering Athletic Meet held by PTU will be awarded Rs.11,000/-.

Note: One student can claim only one scholarship / incentive in one semester. In that case a student having highest scholarship / incentive shall be paid.

Discipline

All students must conform in every respect to the rules of the college. Violation of rules, misconduct, poor attendance, lack of satisfactory progress in studies will render a student liable to fine, rustication, expulsion or other disciplinary measures and action taken by the Principal shall be final.

A student who shall be abstaining from the class for 5 lectures continuously, his/ her parent will be informed.

If a student abstain from the class for 10 days continuously, he/she has to take readmission in the institute after bringing parents and paying Rs. 1000/-.

Attendance

Students are expected to attend classes in theory & practical regularly so that they do not fall short of the university requirement i.e. 75% minimum for appearing in the end semester examination. Any student falling short of attendance will not be allowed to appear in the university examination.

All the **Students** are required to follow the prescribed **Dress code** in the campus.

Hostels

- ❖ Separate hostels are available for boys and girls located on the campus itself. There are three hostels for boys housing approximately 425 students and one hostel for girls having more than 250 girl-students.
- ❖ Each hostel has full-fledged independent mess with the requisite facilities. Main consideration is to provide wholesome, hygienic food which is delectably rich in aroma & taste.
- ❖ Hostels are provided with security guards, caretakers, hostel wardens and hostel superintendents.
- ❖ Rooms furnished with ceiling fans, coolers, geysers & most of them have attached bathrooms.
- ❖ TV., Newspapers, Magazines & Indoor games are also available in the hostels.



General Hostels Rules

- ❖ Students are required to observe strict discipline in hostels. Any attempt to create disturbance/damage to hostel property/ indecent behavior with fellow residents or mess staff/other employees/ warden can lead to disciplinary action including expulsion from the hostel/suspension/ rustication from the college.
- ❖ Absence without prior written permission will lead to disciplinary action.
- ❖ There would be no unnecessary movement or playing of games in the corridors of hostels.
- ❖ No day scholar is allowed to stay in the college campus after the last college bus leaves the campus and on holidays. Similarly no resident student will be allowed to move out of the gate except those who have got the written permission of the hostel warden to cross the college gate for a particular purpose & for a particular period. They need to carry the permission slip & identity card while going out & entering the college gate.
- ❖ Students will not be sitting/playing in the hostel/canteen/lawns during working hours when their respective classes are being held.
- ❖ * Students are responsible for the maintenance of electrical & other fittings in their hostel rooms. They will have to pay for any breakage of these fittings. Any student found damaging/breaking hostel property anywhere would incur disciplinary action besides replacement of the property.
- ❖ Students should not possess or operate any electrically-operated appliances.
- ❖ No intoxicants/weapons/sticks are allowed to be kept/used in the hostel premises.
- ❖ Playing of Loud music is not allowed.
- ❖ No student will take any vehicle towards/near the hostel area. Disobeyance of all mentioned above will lead to strict disciplinary action.
- ❖ Students will not plan or participate in strike/mass-cuts or make unnecessary demands.
- ❖ Students will not directly or indirectly indulge in ragging. The concerned students will have to prove their innocence in case of any reported incident of ragging, failing to do so, he/she will face expulsion from the hostel/college.
- ❖ A resident has to pay for the meals as per the mess rules/mess charges framed from time to time.
- ❖ A non-resident is not allowed to stay in the hostel without prior permission of the Chief Warden otherwise strict disciplinary action will be taken against both resident & non-resident.
- ❖ The Students must get their rooms verified before vacating / leaving the institute, otherwise their security will not be refunded.
- ❖ • Mess timings as fixed by the warden from time to time will be strictly adhered to. A code of decency will be followed in the mess. No meals will be served in the rooms & no mess utensils are to be taken outside the dining hall otherwise very strict action will be taken.
- ❖ No refund of hostel rent (in full or part) will be allowed after the initial allotment even if the student leaves the hostel of his own or is expelled from the hostel. Hostel security will be refundable only when the student leaves the college.
- ❖ Any violation of the above-mentioned rules should be promptly reported to the Chief warden/warden/attendant and students will avoid coming to the Principal directly. Any student found staying back during college hours in hostel & missing classes will be fined & his/her parents will be also informed.
- ❖ No hostler is allowed to carry meal into their rooms unless prior permission is obtained from doctor of the institute on health ground.
- ❖ No hostler will be allowed to leave the hostel and stay outside the campus when the semester is in progress. A hostler can plan to stay outside the campus provided he/ she produce the written consent of the parents and inform the authorities one month in advance before the commencement of next semester.

Students must follow mess timings. No food will be served before & after these timings. Chief warden can change these timings from time to time as per requirements.

- ❖ On institute working days, the breakfast shall be served only upto 9:15 AM so that students may reach the college in time to attend classes.
- ❖ In Break fast, only pre-decided quantity of food items shall be given. If desire, the student can take the extra item by payment of additional cost. Same policy will be applicable in case of desserts or snacks.
- ❖ Best maintained room in both boys & girls hostel shall be awarded. For this, there will be occasional checking regarding cleanliness & maintenance of Rooms by the authorities of the institute. All the room mates of the best room will be awarded suitably.
- ❖ Students can not celebrate their birthday in the hostel rooms without the prior written permission from chief hostel warden.

Additional Rules For Boys Hostel

- ❖ Students (boys) shall mark their attendance daily between 9PM-9:15 PM in the register maintained by the hostel warden.
- ❖ No female guest is allowed to visit resident rooms in boys' hostel.
- ❖ No boys' hostler shall be allowed to enter in the campus after 10 PM unless written permission is taken from the chief hostel warden. At late arrival, the student has to enter the name & signature at the institute gate.
- ❖ Any student found smoking or in possession of intoxicants shall be fined.

Additional Rules For Girls Hostel

- ❖ No girl student will leave hostel/campus without permission of the warden/chief warden/ principal and without making entry in the hostel register and main gate register, noting the exact time of leaving, destination & telephone number. Time of arrival will be noted on return.
- ❖ No girl will be allowed to return to the hostel without the "Permission slip" duly signed by the parents with all entries completed.
- ❖ The students must remain inside the hostel premises by 6:30 pm during summer (April to Sept.) and by 6:00pm during winter (Oct. to March).
- ❖ No male guest is allowed to go beyond the guest room in girls' hostel.
- ❖ Once a girl comes on Monday, she will not be allowed to go home before Friday, unless she has the written permission of the parents or the parents personally come to pick up the resident.
- ❖ Permission slip should be completely filled and signed by the warden.
- ❖ No permission slip will be given to students in advance. The slip will be given at the time of departure with exact time, address and phone number.
- ❖ Girls from distant places are not allowed to leave the hostel after 4.30 pm.
- ❖ Girls are not allowed to visit friends' places/ relatives for night stay unless there is written permission of the parents.
- ❖ No guests are allowed to visit a girl resident except those mentioned by parents in the hostel allotment application. Similarly only those incoming telephone calls will be entertained which the parents in the allotment application have allowed.
- ❖ When the classes are going on girl-students are not allowed to go for movies or shopping.
- ❖ Girls can leave the hostel on holidays during 9:00 am - 4:00 pm only with duly signed slips from the warden.
- ❖ There will be no dance parties in the hostel.

Medical Facilities

- ❖ The college has its own dispensary which provides all medical facilities to the students. In addition to attending to routine ailments, special attention is paid to the over-all health of the students.

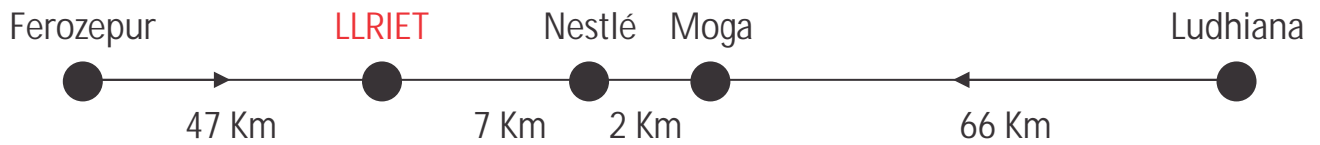
