COLLEGE PROFILE

Background :

Padmashree Late Dr.T.M.A. Pai founded this institution in the year 1963 with the combined efforts of the Academy of General Education, Manipal and the public of Mulki.

Location :

Vijaya College is situated at Mulki, a mofisil town located midway between Mangalore and Udupi on National Highway 66. It is accessible to all means of conveyance. Mulki railway station is 3kms and Mangalore airport is about 20 kms from the College. The College enjoys a serene vicinity and conducive ambience for learning. The College campus layout has a natural variant topography and is hemmed by river Shambavi on one side and the erstwhile fort on the other. The College is flanked by Sri.Durgaparameshwari temple on the west and Sri.Venkatramana Temple and Jain Basadi on the east.

Affiliation :

As per the directions from the Government of Karnataka, the College has been bifurcated into two i.e., Vijaya Pre-University College and Vijaya First Grade College since 2001. At present the First Grade College is affiliated to Mangalore University and Vijaya Pre-university College is affiliated to Pre-University Board, Bangalore, Karnataka.

Faculty :

The College has a band of experienced and dedicated staff, many of whom have Ph.D. and M.Phil. Degrees to their credit with the ultimate aim of providing an education of the highest standard.

Track Record :

Though the College is situated in a rural and educationally backward area, the College has a very good track record of academic and non-academic performance althrough its history. The College has secured 82 University and Pre-University ranks till date. The students have excelled not only in curriculam but also in extra-curricular activites. Our students have represented the University and the State in various extra curricular activities like NCC, NSS, Sports, Clay modelling etc. The College alumni have accomplished themselves in different walks of life. The College attracts students from different parts of Karnataka and also from neighboring states.

ADMISSION PROCEDURES :

Admission for any course is made for one academic year only. Students would be admitted to the next higher class in subsequent academic years on the basis of fresh application for admission to that class taking into account their progress, conduct, regularity in attendance and behavior during the year. The admission process is as follows:-

1. Application forms and Prospectus can be had from the College Office on payment.
2. Application in the prescribed form complete in all respects shall be submitted in person to the respective Principal within a fortnight after the publication of the result of the qualifying examinations.
3. Selected candidates will be called for interview by the Admission Committee of the College. Intimation of interview will be dispatched individually by ordinary post.
4. The applicant called for an interview should be accompanied by his/her parent or guardian (in case of parents not alive) and bring with him/her the following documents all in original without fail;
 - a. Marks Card of the qualifying examination
 - b, Transfer Certificate from the Institution last attended.
 - c. SSLC Certificate
 - d. Conduct Certificate from the Head of the Institution last attended
 - e. Interview card issued by the College
 - f. Six passport size photographs
5. The candidate will be informed about his/her admission/rejection at the end of the interview or later. On admission he/she shall pay forthwith fees of the first installment in the College office.
6. All students who have studied courses other than that of SSLC/PUC of Karnataka shall produce Migration Certificate at the time of admission.
7. If a candidate withdraws after completion of admission process, he/she shall not have any claim to the fees paid by him/her.
8. All admissions made are provisional and subject to the approval of the PU Board, Karnataka/Mangalore University.
9. Every student is required to pay the fees for the entire term for any part of which his/her name is on the rolls of the College.
10. Every student is bound by the rules and regulations framed by the College from time to time in the matter of conduct, attendance, discipline, progress and promotion. The active co-operation from the Parents/Guardians is solicited with regard to the above matters.

INFRASTRUCTURE:

Class Rooms:

The college has spacious and well ventilated class rooms spread across the vast campus. State of the art teaching aids are used regularly.

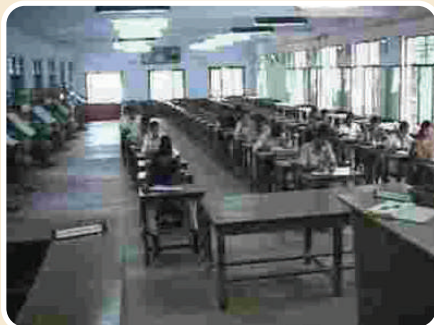
Laboratories:

Well planned and fully equipped laboratories to enable every kind of experimentation. Large number of species and specimen are stacked for the benefit of students. Our Zoology laboratory is a museum of unique kind. The fully air conditioned computer laboratory is networked with more than 60 computers and internet facility.



Library:

The College has well equipped library with around 70,000 books. There is a spacious reading room with magazines, periodicals and dailies in various languages. The College library has also become a source of information for post graduation students and research scholars.



Students' Lounge:

The College has separate recreation and rest rooms for both boys and girls.

Auditorium and Open-air Theatre:

The College auditorium with a seating capacity of about 600 helps in conducting various programmes throughout the year. Programme with larger gatherings are held in the open air theatre.



Audio-visual Hall/Conference Hall :

The College has an audio-visual hall which is frequently used for multi-media enabled classes/programmes and seminars.

Multi-gym :

A huge multi-gym which can accommodate more than 50 students at a time, imparts training in physical culture to the interested students.



Vijaya Darshini :

The College canteen provides clean and tasty food to the students and staff members at subsidized rates.

Annapoorna Hall :

This is a vast dining hall which caters to the need of women students to have their food in the afternoons.



Students' Co-operative Stores:

The Students' Cooperative Stores caters to the stationary requirements of students at marginally discounted price.

Bank:

A full-fledged branch of Syndicate Bank functions on the College Campus for the benefit of students, staff and public.

Public Call Centre :

Coin Box telephone facility is provided both on the College campus and in the hostels.

Xerox Centre :

Photocopying facility at concessional rate is provided to the students.

Playground :

The College has a separate games room for indoor games, courts for volleyball, tennis, softball etc. and a large play ground.

Generators:

Four diesel generators are used as stand-by to supply power.

Hostels :

Separate hostel facility for boys and girls is provided to the outstation students at reasonable fees. Vegetarian food is provided on sharing basis.

Internet Browsing Centre:

Browsing facility is provided to the students at no profit and no loss basis.



STUDENT ACTIVITIES :

Sports and Games :

Adequate emphasis is given on sports and games to foster the physical and mental well-being of the students. The College has the credit of organizing umpteen number of inter-collegiate, University and state level sports events and games competitions.



NSS :

The College has an NSS unit, which conducts social service activities on weekends and organizes special camps in rural areas during holidays.

NCC :

The College has both NCC army and naval units. NCC training in both the wings is given to both boys and girls as per the NCC syllabi. In addition to the routine weekend parades, special ceremonial parades on National festivals and adventure activities like cycling, trekking and rock climbing are conducted by the units.



HRD & TQM Cell :

The Cell conducts awareness and training programmes for students, administrative staff and teaching staff in personality development, soft skills, human relations etc. to make them more effective and efficient in their respective fields.

CODE OF CONDUCT FOR STUDENTS

- 1. Use of Mobiles :** Carrying and use of cell phones on the campus(including library) is strictly prohibited. On the violation of this rule, the cell phones are seized and will not be returned.
- 2. Identity Card :** All students should wear I.D.cards on all working days even during special classes conducted on working days other than sundays and public holidays.
- 3. Uniform :** Except on Saturdays, public holidays and annual day celebrations, all students must attend the classes in uniform. Wearing of Jeans pants and T-shirts is prohibited.
- 4. Attendance :** Students who remain absent for all classes on any particular day must produce the leave note duly signed by parents/guardian before attending the classes next day. In case any student is absent for more than one day, along with the leave letter signed by parents/guardians, he or she would obtain the permission of the principal before attending the classes.
- 5. Attendance for examinations :** Attendance is compulsory for all the examinations. Unless there is genuine reason no student is allowed to remain absent. He or she is permitted to take the re-examination only on the payment of Rs.100 per subject. However such re-examinations will not be conducted for the students who absent themselves without prior permission from the principal.
- 6. Condonation of Attendance :** Those students who take part in inter-collegiate competitions/programmes approved by the principal are given attendance for the classes lost.
- 7. Admissions :** Presence of parents is compulsory at the time of admission. Guardians can be present only if the parents are not alive.
- 8. Parent-Teacher Meetings :** It is mandatory on the part of the parents to attend these meetings without fail. Only when the parents are not alive, guardians can attend these meetings.
