Emblem And Motto :

The Executive Council of the University in its meeting on 11-02-2013, has approved the Emblem of the University wherein the motto "**SARASVATĪ ŚRUTIMAHATĀM MAHĪYATĀM**" (May the sayings of the wise be glorified) which is a quotation from Kālidāsa, is also inscribed.

Vision:

To become a substantial contributor towards making of a society of people enlightened with knowledge which is pure and eternal.

Mission :

To carry on continuous effort for building the University an important and singular one of its genre by way of dissemination of knowledge with concerted thrust upon extracting the best of potentialities inherent in every individual.

Objectives:

The University stands for imparting education leading to graduate and post graduate degrees and research degrees viz. M.Phil. and Ph.D. in Sanskrit and research degrees (M.Phil and Ph. D.) only in Ancient Studies. At the same time, with the provision of the Act, the university introduces academic programmes in Humanities, Social Sciences as well as other disciplines as per societal requirements.

The University (Crest):

The University has adopted a Kalidasean line meaning "may the sayings of the wise be glorified", as its motto. Knowledge is an eternal entity and dissemination of knowledge is what a university stands for. The motto is inscribed on a wrapped sheet of paper at the middle of the emblem. The quill used as a writing pen even till a few decades ago and the two burning earthen lights indicate the process of learning, which is as pure and bright as the sun, inscribed at the centre. The five concentric circles be taken to suggest that knowledge /learning can be had of with the five organs, both sensory as well as cognitive. Moreover the shade of saffron colour spreading towards the circumference is an indication that knowledge is meant for expansion with no boundary at all, the fact applicable in regard to the purpose of a University.

The History of Origin:

The University is set up with a notification by the Govt. of Assam dated 24th May, 2011, of the Kumar Bhaskar Varma Sanskrit and Ancient Studies University Act, 2011, which received assent of the Hon'ble Governor of Assam on 16th March, 2011. The Preamble of the Act states that by this Act, the Govt. of Assam goes "to establish and constitute a teaching, affiliating, research and residential University at Nalbari," the Headquarters of the district of Nalbari, Assam. Kumar Bhaskar Varma, a great monarch of Assam (7th century A.D) was a patron of Sanskrit studies and during his rule Vedic culture and Sanskrit knowledge came to flourish in Assam.

The University is at present functioning from two buildings offered by the authorities of Nalbari College, Nalbari. The state Government has already allotted 100 (one hundred) bighas of land for setting up the permanent campus of the University. The campus is at village Namati of Batahgila Mouza under Nalbari Revenue circle of the district of Nalbari, Assam, which is at a distance of 3.3 km from the 31 National Highway. The construction work of the university campus is going on in the permanent campus. It is expected to run the University from its own campus at Namati soon.

Admission Process :

Procedure

Collection of Admission Forms and Submission

Prescribed Application Forms for admission to all the courses are available along with the prospectus at the cost of Rs 200/- each. The forms can be collected

- i) directly from the University office paying Rs. 200.00 through the university challan
- ii) by depositing Bank Draft of Rs 200.00 drawn in favour of Kumar Bhaskar Varma Sanskrit & Ancient Studies University payable at Nalbari.
- iii) by post, request for admission form must be accompanied by a self addressed envelope of 25cmx30cm size with postage stamp of Rs 40 (forty) only along with a bank draft for Rs 200/- (two hundred) only.
- iv) the Admission Form can also be downloaded from the university Website (www.kbvsasu.in) However, candidates will have to pay Rs.200/- through university challan at the time of admission.

The dates for Submission of application form, interview and admission are notified in the university notice board and are also available in the university website.

A student must produce all relevant documents in original and two copies of passport size photographs at the time of interview and admission.

Admission is done in order of merit and is followed by the university admission regulation.

The provision of reservation of seats for students belonging to SC/ST/(P)/ST(H)/OBC/MOBC categories is as per the state government rules. In such case attested copies of certificate of the caste of the reserved category must be enclosed along with the application form.

A student applying for the EC (Extra curricular Activity) quota must write clearly "Application for EC Quota" on the top of the application form and be enclosed with the attested copies of the supporting documents.

The students selected must get themselves admitted on the scheduled day of interview otherwise, their claim for admission will be forfeited.

Courses of Studies :

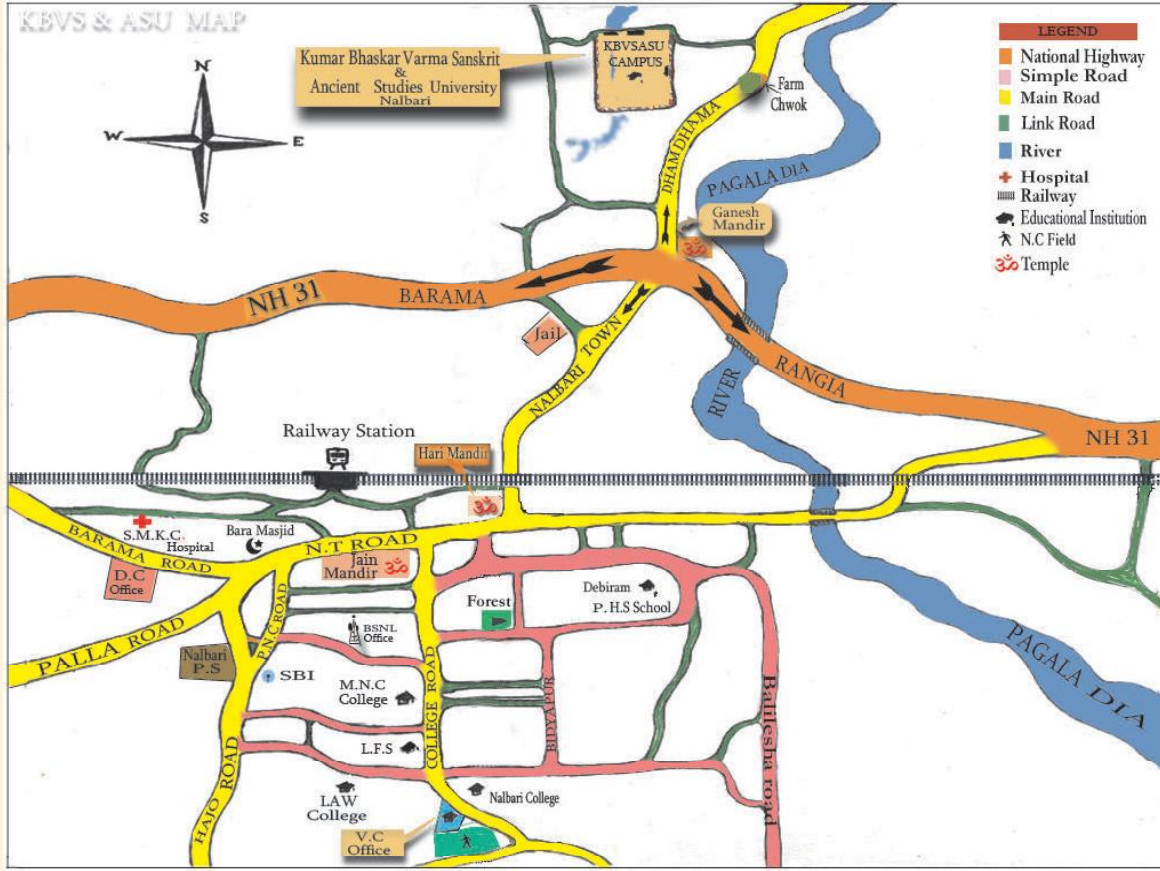
- ▲ MA in Sanskrit (Sāhitya)
- ▲ MA in Education
- ▲ 5 year integrated MA in Sanskrit
- ▲ Certificate Course in Communicative Sanskrit (compulsory for students other than Sanskrit.)

Regulations for the Certificate in Communicative Sanskrit :

(Vāṇīpraveśa) (वाणीप्रवेशः)

1. The course is compulsory for the Students of all the subjects excluding those belonging to the School of Sanskrit Studies.
2. The course will be of 3 months duration and will commence from 1st Feb to 30th April of the 2nd Semester.
3. The total marks for the course will be of 200. There will be two Theory papers of 75 marks each and one Practical Paper of 50 marks. The pass mark of the theory papers will be 40 per cent of the total theory marks and for practical paper 50 per cent of the total practical marks.
4. A group discussion on the course will be held in the month of April.
5. The final Examination on the course will be held in the month of May and the result will be declared before the End semester examination
6. The unsuccessful candidates will get the chance to clear the subject during Even Semester.
7. The course fees is Rs.600/- (may be changed from time to time). However students who will appear in the examination as an arrear subject will have to pay Rs.200/- as examination fee at the time of filling up the examination form.
8. A separate Certificate will be awarded to the successful candidates.

Academic Programme:

Govt. of Assam has already communicated with the University recognizing the degrees/diplomas/certificates of the courses to be introduced by the University. University Grant Commission (UGC) vide its letter No.F.9-5/2013(CPP-I/PU), dated-8/5/2013 has also empowered the University to award degree/diploma/certificates.  - ❖ Manuscript Studies.
 - ❖ Proficiency in Ayurvedic texts.

B. School of Ancient Studies :

M. Phil/Ph.D programmes in the centers namely

- Language Studies.
- Religion Studies.
- Culture Studies.
- Scientific Literature Studies.

C. School of Humanities :

- ◆ PG Courses (M.A, M. Phil, and Ph.D) in the Department of Assamese, Education, English, Philosophy, History and Economics.
- ◆ Four year Integrated Courses in Teachers' Education (B.A B.Ed)
- ◆ 01 (one) year Diploma in Elementary Education (for Primary and ME school teachers)
- ◆ A 03 (three) month Certificate Course in Communicative Sanskrit (Vāṅpraveśa) (mandatory for students belonging to disciplines other than School of Sanskrit studies.)

Present Academic Programme:

The University has started its academic activities from its present temporary campus from the academic year 2013-14. Classes are going on of PG classes leading to the degree of M.A in Sanskrit (Sāhitya) under School of Sanskrit Studies and Education under School of Humanities.

Five year Integrated MA Course in Sanskrit: the admission to the Five year Integrated MA Course in Sanskrit has been started from the academic year 2014-15. The notification for admission to the course has already been done.

Eligibility for admission to the M.A. Course:

1. B.A. with Major/Honours in the concerned subject (in the 10+2+3 pattern).
2. B.A. with General/Pass Course with at least 45 % marks in the concerned subject as well as in aggregate.
3. Śāstrī (recognized by any University) for M.A in Sanskrit.

Eligibility for admission to the Five year Integrated M.A. Course in Sanskrit.

H. S. or equivalent examination in Arts/ Science / Commerce stream (10+2 pattern) or Prāg Upādhi / Prāg Śāstrī with at least 50 % marks

Some Important Celebrations:

The University observes Republic Day, Independence Day etc. in its campus. Students are well advised to participate in the events. The University also observe the National Sanskrit Day on Śrāvaṇī Pūrṇimā colourfully.

Attendance Rule:

Attendance in class is compulsory. Students who do not attend at least 75% of the classes will forfeit the benefit of scholarship and other facilities and will not be allowed to appear in any final examination.

Assessment:

Continuous assessment of the student is done by the department through regular tests, seminars, projects, assignment etc.

Ragging free Campus:

The entire University campus is declared by the university authorities as a ragging free one. Anybody found indulging in ragging is liable to be punished as per law of the university and Govt. rules in this regard.

Students Grievance Redressal Cell:

The university has constituted a Grievance Redressal Cell comprising a group of faculty members headed by the Registrar of the university who interact with the students and address their different academic and non-academic problems.

Glimpses of the activities of the Students:

The students of the Sanskrit (Sāhitya) of the University secured 1st Prize in the State level Chorus Competition (in Sanskrit) held at Cotton College on the eve of Sanskrit week Celebration during Śrāvaṇī Pūrṇimā from 16th to 22nd August, 2013, organized by MHRD, Govt. of India New Delhi.



The Students also secured 2nd Prize in the District level Chorus Competition held at Nalbari College.

The Students also participated in a National Seminar held at **Lucknow** 13-09-2013 to 15-09-2013 organized by **Rastriya Sanskrit Sansthan**.

About the Permanent Campus :

The permanent campus of the KBVS & ASU has been developed at Namati village of Bataghila mouza under Nalbari Revenue Circle of the district of Nalbari. It has an area of 100 Bighas of land allotted by the Govt. of Assam. The campus is located at 3.3 KM north of the 31 National Highway along the Nalbari-Dhamdhama PWD Road. It is easily accessible by public and private transport facilities. The University is connected by Railways from Nalbari Railways Station and it is at a distance of 75 KM from the Gopinath Bordoloi International Air port.

Library:

The university has a good collection of text and reference books and journals .The students can borrow books for a specified period after depositing of necessary caution money.

Medium of Instruction:

Sanskrit is the medium of instruction in the Departments under School of Sanskrit Studies at UG and PG Courses. However, in other courses of studies, English is the medium of instruction.

Identity Card:

The Identity card is essential for being recognized as a student of the university, and must be produced when demanded. The Identity card is non transferable and is issued to each student in the time of admission and in the beginning of every academic session. The card must be duly signed by the Registrar/OSD and properly Stamped. Duplicate Identity Card is issued in case of loss or damage of the card with specific evidence, on payment of Rs 100/- . For receiving the Scholarship and availing the students' concession in any occasion, the student must have to submit the Identity Card.

Scholarship:

The following Scholarships can be availed by the eligible students

- ✦ SC/ST Scholarship
- ✦ OBC/MOBC Scholarship

Registration:

Students must have to get registration in the university by filling up a prescribed registration form and paying registration fees of the amount of Rs.400/- through University challan.

Migration:

The Students enrolled to this University from other university must submit the migration certificate before registration to this university.

Students and teachers can avail students' concession on railway travel in academic purposes and to their home during the vacation of the university or other academic purposes.

Sir,

With reference to your Letter No. KBVS&ASU/EG-12/2012/36 dated 30.03.2013 on the above subject, I am directed to say that Kumar Bhaskar Varma Sanskrit & Ancient Studies University, Nalbari (Assam) has been established by an Act (No. 09 of 2011) of State Legislature of Assam as a State University vide Notification No. LGL.83/2010/32 dated 24.05.2011 and is empowered to award degrees as specified by the UGC under section 22 of the UGC Act 1956 through its main campus in regular mode with the approval of its statutory bodies/councils, wherever required.

The University is not allowed to start any off-campus centre beyond the territorial jurisdiction of the State as per Hon'ble Supreme Court Judgement in Prof. Yash Pal vs State of Chhattisgarh case.

The University may note and adhere to the following: -

- i) To ensure that no off campus centre(s)/study centre and the centres operating through franchises is opened by the University outside the territorial jurisdiction of the State in view of the judgement of Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in case of Prof. Yashpal vs. Government of Chhattisgarh.
- ii) In case the university has already started any off-campus/study centre and the centre operating through franchises outside the State, it must be closed immediately.
- iii) No distance education programmes shall be started without the prior approval of Distance Education Council as it is the regulatory body for distance education programmes.
- iv) The University to conduct Ph.D. programmes as per the provisions of UGC (Minimum Standards and Procedure for Awards of M.Phil/Ph.D. Degree) Regulations, 2009.

I am enclosing a copy of UGC (Fitness of Certain Universities for Grants) Rules, 1974. The detailed information in the prescribed format (attached) may please be sent to this office for considering the proposal to declare University fit to receive Central assistance under Section 12B of UGC Act, 1956.

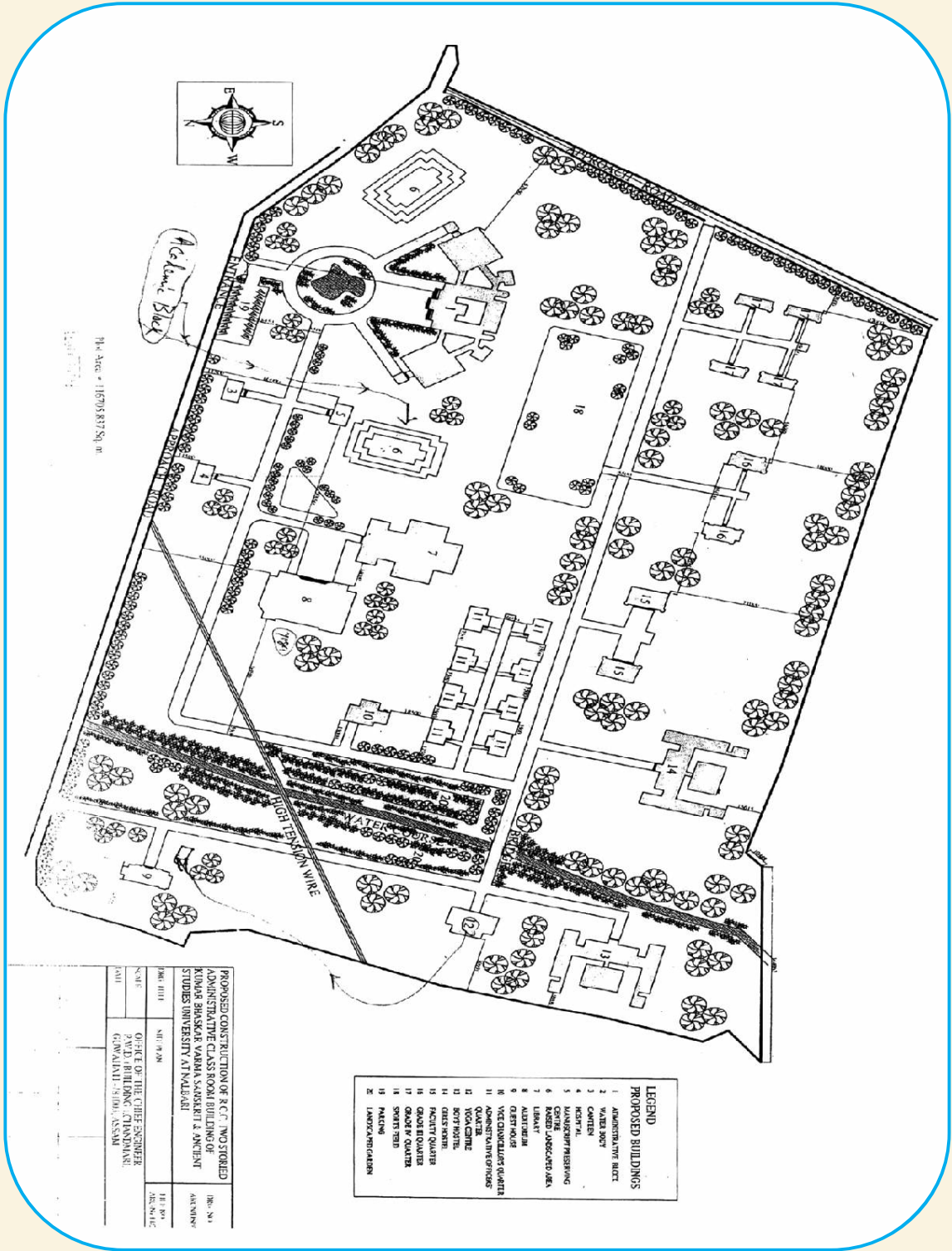
