### **SPECIALISATION IN POST GRADUATE COURSES (M.PHARM)**

#### **Pharmaceutics - 10 seats**

Pharmaceutics is the discipline of pharmacy that deals with the process of turning a new chemical entity (NCE) into a medication to be used safely and effectively by patients. It is also called the science of dosage/ form/ design. There are many chemicals with pharmacological properties, but need special measures to help them achieve therapeutically relevant amounts at their sites of action. Pharmaceutics helps relate the formulation of drugs to their delivery and disposition in the body. Pharmaceutics deals with the formulation of a pure drug substance into a dosage form. The department of Pharmaceutics provides training and expertise in drug formulation, delivery and inter relationships between in vitro and in vivo drug disposition to students as a prerequisite qualification for a career in the Pharmaceutical industry or as an academic scientist.

#### **Pharmacology - 18 seats**

Pharmacology is the branch of medicine and biology concerned with the study of drug action, where a drug can be broadly defined as any man-made,

natural, or endogenous (within the body) molecule which exerts a biochemical and/or physiological effect on the cell, tissue, organ, or organism. More specifically, it is the study of the interactions that occur between a living organism and chemicals that affect normal or abnormal biochemical function.

### **Pharmacognosy and Phytochemistry - 18 seats**

Pharmacognosy represents a highly interdisciplinary science, which is one among four major areas of pharmaceutical education. Pharmacognosy is a multi disciplinary subject that comprises parts of Pharmaceutics, Pharmacology and Pharmaceutical chemistry. Pharmacognosy is the study of medicines derived from natural sources. The American Society of Pharmacognosy defines Pharmacognosy as "the study of the physical, chemical, biochemical and biological properties of drugs, drug substances or potential drugs or drug substances of natural origin as well as the search for new drugs from natural sources. It is also defined as the study of crude drugs.

### **SELECTION PROCEDURE- ALL COURSES**

#### **Management quota**

Based on merit, and merit will be decided on the basis of the marks obtained in the qualifying examinations and by a personal interview. Rank list will be formed by taking 80% marks from the qualifying examination and 20% from the interview.

#### **N.R.I quota**

NRI seats are defined as those seats set apart for the Son/Daughter, Brother/Sister, Niece/Nephew, First cousin or Dependant of Non-Resident Indian citizen or as defined in the order GO(MS)193/2013/H & FWD, Thiruvananthapuram dt 22/05/13.

NRI candidates seeking admission to Academy of Pharmaceutical Sciences should enclose a copy of the following documents to prove the status of the NRI sponsor and declaration of the NRI in the prescribed form to establish his/her relationship with the candidate:

- a) Attested copy of the relevant pages of the Passport containing Visa details.
- b) Attested copy of the Employment Certificate.

c) Certificate issued by a Scheduled Bank stating that sponsor (He/She) is a Non-resident Indian holding an NRI account other than a Zero balance account.

d) Certificate showing the relation to applicant issued by Village Officer.

Selection based on merit of qualifying examination and an interview.

**Criteria of Eligibility for Admission to B.Pharm, M.Pharm and Pharm D courses:**

**1. B.Pharm**

For admission to BPharm Course, candidates who have passed Higher Secondary Examination, Kerala or examinations recognized as equivalent thereto, with 50% marks in Biology/Mathematics/Biochemistry/Computer Science separately and 50% marks in Physics, Chemistry and Biology/Mathematics/Biochemistry/Computer Science put together are eligible. Candidates from National Open School are not eligible to apply for the course.

**Lateral Admission- BPharm**

**Minimum qualification for admission directly to the second year of the BPharm course (Lateral admission)**

A candidate who has passed the Diploma in Pharmacy course (Educational Regulations 1991) under Pharmacy act 1948 from an institution approved by the Pharmacy Council of India with a minimum of 50% marks in the final year examinations is eligible for admission. Direct admission of Diploma holders in Pharmacy to the second year B. Pharm course is subject to the ceiling of approved strength of the first year course by the Pharmacy Council of India and All India Council for Technical Education.

Candidates belonging to Socially and Educationally Backward Classes as per G.O.(P) No. 208/66/Edn dated 02/05/1966, G.O (MS) No. 95/08/SCSTDD dated 06/10/2008 and amendments thereof, with a total annual family income not exceeding Rs. 4.5 lakhs, will have a relaxation of 5% marks in the qualifying examination. The Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes candidates need only a pass in the qualifying examination.

Applicants should have completed 17 years of age on the 31<sup>st</sup> December of the year of admission to the course. No relaxation of the minimum age will be allowed.

## **2. M.Pharm**

A candidate who has passed the B.Pharm degree examination of Kerala University of Health Sciences or an examination equivalent thereto of any other university recognized by Kerala University of Health Sciences with not less than a total of 55% marks for the B.Pharm degree examination shall be eligible for admission to M.Pharm degree course. The candidate should have undergone B.Pharm degree course in an institution approved by AICTE and the PCI.

If a Post Graduate student discontinues the P.G course after expiry of the validity period of the select list he/she shall pay total amount of fee declared for the course as Liquidated Damages and a bond to be executed to the effect.

Format of Bond will be available in the office of the Principal of the Pharmacy College concerned. No candidate shall be permitted to do post graduate course in more than one specialty simultaneously.

Only Indian citizens are eligible for admission to the MPharm course. They have to provide the certificate of nativity along with the application form in this regard.

## **3. Pharm D**

Minimum qualification for admission to;

(i) For admission to Pharm. D Course- candidates who have passed Higher Secondary Examination, Kerala or examinations recognized as equivalent thereto, with 50% marks in Biology/Mathematics separately and 50% marks in Physics, Chemistry and Biology/Mathematics put together are eligible.

OR

(ii) A pass in D. Pharm. Course with a minimum of 50% marks in D. Pharm. Examination from an institution approved by Pharmacy Council of India under Section 12 of the Pharmacy Act. (20% of the total seats is reserved for candidates with D.Pharm. qualification). If DPharm candidates are not available, these seats shall be filled up by candidates who have academic eligibility as per Clause (i).

### **Duration of the course**

**a) Pharm. D:** The duration of the course shall be six academic years (five years of study and one year of internship or residency) full time with each academic year spread over a period of not less than two hundred working days. The period of six years duration is divided into two phases;

Phase I — consisting of First, Second, Third, Fourth and Fifth academic year.

Phase II - consisting of internship or residency training during sixth year involving posting in speciality units. It is a phase of training wherein a student is exposed to actual pharmacy practice or clinical pharmacy services and acquires skill under supervision so that he or she may become capable of functioning independently.

#### ***B. Pharm/ Pharm D Course***

1. Attested copy of mark list of qualifying examination.
2. A self addressed stamped envelope (12 x 25 cms size)
3. Attested copy of relevant page of school records namely SSLC/ISC/CBSE certificate showing the date of birth should be furnished as proof of age.
4. Declaration from the NRI sponsor of the applicant
5. Document to prove the NRI status of the sponsor (For NRI Candidate).

### ***Certificates/documents to be submitted along with the application for***

#### ***M. Pharm Course***

- a. True copy of the S.S.L.C book or any relevant records to prove date of birth.
- b. Any one of the certificates to prove nativity, in the prescribed format.
- c. Certificates in support of claim for Communal Reservation, in the prescribed format.
- d. Inter-Caste marriage certificate in prescribed format, if applicable.
- e. Attested copy of Certificate of the Medical Board for Persons with Disabilities.
- f. Copy of the "Admit Card of GPAT-2013 examination" (Except service candidates)

- g. Certificate in support of Academic qualification, Service, declaration of probation and other documents (for service candidates).

#### **MODE OF ADMISSION:**

Based on merit of the qualifying examination, (Reservation as per Government norms) 50% of the total Merit seats should be filled in by the Government/University from the merit list of the qualifying examination, in keeping with all the reservation rules and the Fee structure laid down by the Government of Kerala from time to time. The remaining 50% of the seats can be filled by the respective Managements, as per the norms specified by the State Government from time to time. 20% of the seats to be reserved for D.Pharm candidates in both merit Quota and Management Quota. In case sufficient number of eligible D. Pharm. Candidates are not available, other candidates as per the qualifications specified by the Pharmacy Council of India may be given admission.

#### **HOW TO APPLY**

##### **Application Forms:**

Application form will be available from the office of the Principal, Academy of Pharmaceutical Sciences, Pariyaram on all working days from 10A.M to 5.00P.M from 15/05/14 onwards till 07/06/14 (NRI seats BPharm/ PharmD) and till 14/06/14 for admission under management. MPharm applications available from 15/05/14 till 30/06/14.

##### **a. Cost of Application forms:**

The cost of application form will be Rs. 500/- (Rupees five hundred only).

- b.** The filled in application form with all the required certificates/documents shall be submitted to the office of the Principal, Academy of Pharmaceutical Sciences, Pariyaram, Kannur - 670 503 and will be accepted upto 5 P.M on the last day of acceptance of application.

- c.** Separate application should be submitted for each course and category.

#### **I. SPECIAL FEATURES/DISCIPLINE/ADDITIONAL INFORMATION**

- a. All students who get selected should be vaccinated against hepatitis (A+B), Chicken pox, MMR before admission. A certificate to the effect has to be submitted at the time of admission or before commencement of the course.

- b. If any candidate discontinues/leaves the Institution within a period of 15 days before the closing of admission in the first year or any time after closing admission in first year, or discontinues/leaves the Institution in the subsequent years, he/she is liable to pay the fees for the remaining years i.e. fees for the whole duration of course. In such cases transfer Certificate and other certificates of the student concerned will be issued only after the payment of the fees for the remaining years.
- c. Yearly remittance of fee on specified dates for the normal duration of course is mandatory.
- d. Ragging is strictly prohibited in the College Campus. An efficient anti ragging committee is constituted with the participation of students, staff members, parents and public. Any type of ragging in the campus is strictly prohibited. If a case is reported against a student he/she will be given chance to explain himself/herself and if the explanation is not satisfactory he/she will be expelled from the institution/suitable punishment given without further notice. Other criminal/ legal procedures will also be allowed.
- e. All students admitted will be insured against illness/ accidents through National Insurance Scheme every year for whole duration of course and premium payable will be collected from the student concerned, during admission.
- f. All students who are selected should obey the rules & regulations of the Institution without fail. Students are expected to observe absolute discipline in their conduct during the entire period they spend in the institution. Failure to observe absolute discipline will invite appropriate action.
- g. Hostel facilities are limited
- h. Students should wear prescribed uniform with name plate on the chest during working hours. Students are expected to dress up neatly and decently. Jeans/ Baggies/ T Shirts/ short skirts and the likes are not permitted to be worn inside the hospital/college.
- i. Mobile phones are not permitted at the academic areas and hospitals

- j. No scholarships or admission reservations for SC/ST/OEC given from Institution.
- k. The candidates should satisfy the eligibility conditions on the date of submission of application form
- l. All candidates should read and sign the declaration
- m. Incomplete/ defective/late Applications will be rejected.
- n. Attendance & Leave: A minimum of 80% attendance in each academic year is compulsory. (separate for theory and practical)
- o. Rules and regulations as prescribed should be strictly followed at the college, hospital and hostels.
- p. Smoking and alcoholic drinks are totally prohibited
- q. Applicants shall obtain acknowledgement from the college office for the applications submitted in person.
- r. Photocopies of Certificates/Documents, attested by a Gazetted Officer or the head of the Institution last studied should be submitted along with the application.
