❑ RULES OF ADMISSION ❑

1. Application must be made in the prescribed admission form only.
 2. Incomplete applications and those received after the notified date will not be considered.
 3. An admission form must be appended with :
 - (A) An attested photocopy of School / College Leaving Certificate.
 - (B) An attested photocopy of Statement of Marks of the qualifying examination.
 - (C) An attested photocopy of Character Certificate.
 - (D) An attested photocopy of No Objection Certificate (only for the employed learners).
- (Note : The original documents must be furnished at the time of admission)**
4. An applicant who has passed the qualifying examination from a Board other than M.S. Board of Secondary and Higher Secondary Exam, Amravati and Nagpur Board or S.G.B. Amravati University will have to submit Migration Certificate on or before 1st Sept., of the current academic year.
 5. Application form must be accompanied with one additional passport photograph for Identity Card. **N.B.** : Side view photograph will not be accepted.
 6. The list of eligible students will be displayed on the notice board from time to time. No interview card will be sent.
 7. Eligible students will have to attend an interview along with his / her parent/ guardian at his / her own expense.
 8. Seats are reserved for candidates belonging to S. C. / S. T. / V. J. N. T. / O. B. C. / S. B. C. etc. as per the government rules.
 9. The students seeking admission to B.A.- II, B.A.-III, B.Com.-II, B.Com.-III, M.A.-II, M.Com.-II on the basis of A.T.K.T. must have cleared at least 50% (or the required number) of subjects. For more information refer ordinance no. 10 of S.G.B. Amravati University.
 10. Students securing admission on the basis of A.T.K.T. facility, shall be governed by the government rules in respect of E.B.C. concession.
 11. Students who have passed D.Ed./M.C.V.C. are eligible for admission to B.A.-I or B.Com.-I.
 12. Final decision regarding admission rests with the Admission Committee and the Principal.

GENERAL INFORMATIONS & INSTRUCTIONS FOR STUDENTS

□ E.B.C. CONCESSION □

- a) E.B.C. form should be submitted to the college as per guidelines displayed on the college notice board with income certificate of the year 2013-14 and two attested copies of ration card.
- b) Students hailing from villages with population below 10,000 will have to submit income certificate duly signed by village Sarpanch. Income Certificate issued by Deputy-Sarpanch will not be accepted. Those who are from a locality with population above 10,000 will have to submit Income Certificate duly signed by a Revenue Officer not below the rank of Tahsildar.
- c) A student below the age of 18 years will have to submit concession forms duly signed by his / her parent or legitimate guardian to claim E.B.C. concession.
- d) To be eligible for E.B.C. concession a student must secure 75% of attendance in each subject every month and show satisfactory progress in Unit Tests and Terminal Exams. Those who do not fulfil these conditions shall not be deemed eligible for E.B.C. concession.
- e) The students claiming E.B.C. concession must attach the original copy of the Court Affidavit signed by a Magistrate for the gap period, if any, to the E.B.C. Form.
- f) After submitting E.B.C. concession forms or scholarship forms students are advised to obtain acknowledgement of the same.

❑ SCHOLARSHIPS & AWARDS ❑

The general terms & conditions laid down by the college for award of various scholarships & awards are given below -

- 1) Applicant must be a resident of Maharashtra.
- 2) The duly filled in application forms should be submitted to the college office within two weeks of securing admission. The acknowledgement received thereafter should be kept for future reference.
- 3) Application forms will be available in the college office after 3 p.m. on all working days.

- 1) Students must attend atleast 75% of the lectures (including practicals) in each class in order to get eligible for Board / University exams.
- 2) Students who fall short of the requisite attendance without substantial reason will be fined as per the rules and be barred from taking University / Board examination.
- 3) The names of students who remain absent for a long period will be removed from the college rolls.

❑ DISCIPLINE & CODE OF CONDUCT ❑

- 1) It is obligatory on the part of the students to possess prescribed text books and other relevant study materials.

- 2) Systematic, satisfactory & timely completion of home assignments is mandatory. Any failure on this front will be deemed as an act of indiscipline and may invite fine. The college will seriously consider this fact while determining eligibility of students for University / Board exams.
- 3) Students must not cause damage to or destroy college property. Any misuse or damage caused intentionally or unintentionally will invite stringent punishment. All the students from the class involved in the misact will be held responsible collectively for any damage in the particular class, unless the individual offender is identified.
- 4) Students shall maintain decorum in the college premises. Any indiscipline or misbehaviour, both inside and outside the college premises will attract severe punishment. The names of students found guilty of misconduct will be removed from the college rolls.
- 5) Students must enter their respective classes before the period bell goes. They should utilise their free time in the college library. Students should not cause any disturbance to teaching as well as general functioning of the college.
- 6) No student will be allowed to participate in or attend any activity in the college without identity card.
- 7) The students are directed to record permanent address/ contact numbers of their parents / guardians. Any change in this respect must be brought to the notice of college office immediately.
- 8) It is the responsibility of the students / parents / guardians to find out to which scholarships (enlisted on page no. 32) the student is eligible for and to apply accordingly for the same along with the required documents.
- 9) Any difficulty faced by the student should be brought to the notice of the Principal or the Registrar.
- 10) **Smoking, gutka, pan chewing and taking banned drugs and narcotics in college campus is strictly prohibited.**
- 11) No student will send anything concerning the college for publication without prior permission of the Principal.
- 12) Any political movement, demonstration or agitation involving the name of the college is strictly prohibited.
- 13) Students shall see the college notice board daily. The college will not be held responsible for any loss arising out of any negligence in this regard.
- 14) **Ragging is strictly prohibited. Any student found guilty will be proceeded against under Maharashtra Government Ordinance No. 33 dated 15 May, 1999 and will be expelled from the college forthwith.**
- 15) No outside artists will be allowed to take part in the college cultural activities.
- 16) Students must keep with them photocopies of all the documents submitted to the college office. The documents once submitted will not be returned for any temporary cause. Photocopies of the documents may be made available to the student under extraordinary conditions on payment of 10 per copy.
- 17) Students must collect their original documents, if any, within three years of leaving the college. Thereafter 10 will be charged as fine per document per year.

- 18) The details of the uniform wearings as finalised by the college are given below :
For Boys - Sky Blue Shirt & Navy Blue Pants.
For Girls - Sky Blue Kurta, Navy Blue Salwar & Dupatta.
- 19) Women's Grievance Committee has been formed in the college by the Notification No. SGBAU 772012 dt. 21/06/2012.
- 20) Be honest, upright and straightforward in all your dealings.
- 21) If you are intelligent, let your classmates be benefitted by your intelligence.
- 22) Utilise every minute of your leisure well. Always use polite language.
- 23) To make any changes in the chosen subjects the students must convey to the office before 15th of August.

□ NO VEHICLE DAY □

To save Mother Earth and to protect the environment, '**NO VEHICLE DAY**' will be observed on **20th day of every month**. Students should not use petrol or diesel vehicle in or around the college campus.

□ COLLEGE EXAMINATIONS □

- 1) All students will compulsorily have to appear for the following examinations.
a) Three Class-Room Unit Tests. b) One Terminal Exam.
- 2) Those remaining absent from the above exams without sufficient cause will be fined as per the rules framed by the Examination Committee and may not be allowed to appear at the Final University / Board Examination.
- 3) Junior College Examinations shall be held as per the set rules.

□ IDENTITY CARD □

- 1) All the students shall be issued Identity Cards. No students without Identity Card will be allowed to enter the campus.
- 2) The students must keep wearing the Identity Cards so long as they are on the college campus.
- 3) No student will be allowed to attend or participate in any activity inside or outside the college campus without Identity Card.
- 4) If the Identity Card is lost, a fresh one will be issued on payment of 50=00.

□ LIBRARY □

- 1) Under-graduate students will be issued **TWO** Borrower's Tickets .
- 2) Post-graduate students will be issued **FOUR** Borrower's Tickets.
- 3) In case the B.T. is lost, duplicate B. T. can be had on payment of 10/- each.

- 4) Any damage to the book issued should be brought to the notice of issuing person before leaving the counter or else the student concerned will be held responsible for the damage.
- 5) The students must return the books on or before the specified date. Any delay will attract a fine of 1/- per day.
- 6) If a book is lost the student will have to replace the same or pay twice the cost of the book in addition to a fine of 100/- per book.
- 7) Journals, periodicals and newspapers are available in the reading room. The same will be issued on furnishing Identity Cards.
- 8) Library facility is open to **Approved Research Scholars** and **Research Guides** as per the College Library rules.
- 9) Complaints & suggestions shall be addressed to the convener of the Library Committee. Principal's decision shall stay final in this regard.
- 10) Every student should withdraw atleast five books in a month.
- 11) With a view to boosting reading habit among the students Library Association is founded. Besides the college students, the parents are also awarded eligibility and are welcome to avail the membership of the Association. For this they will have to pay the membership fee of 10/- as stipulated by the Library Committee.
- 12) **Research students can avail the facility of the library by depositing the required fees.**

❑ **WOMENS HOSTEL** ❑

Women -Empowerment - Not mere a Lip- Service, But A Realistic Leap from the Institution towards its actualisation. Women's Hostel - Now a dream come true reality for our girl-students. A new Women's Hostel building on the campus with 48 intake capacity is beckoning our girls students to provide them with comforts & coziness of their homes, It is all set to open in the academic year 2014-15.

❑ **GAMES AND SPORTS** ❑

The college is the most successful academic institution in the field of games and sports in the region. This has happened largely by virtue of the incentives and encouragements the college gives to the budding sporting talents to groom them into sports personalities of renown. The students with sporting talents are welcome to this institution. We have been producing 50 plus university colours and an enviable number of championships every year for last one decade or so. Last year **04 teams** of the college won University Championship in various games in addition to **54 colours holders** (including Ashwamedh).

❑ **PHYSICAL EFFICIENCY TEST AND MEDICAL EXAMINATION** ❑

- 1) It is compulsory for all the students except the N.C.C. Cadets, N.S.S. Volunteers and for those who participate in the inter-collegiate tournaments to attend physical training classes. In case a student fails to secure 80% of attendance in these classes, he shall be fined as per the rules.
- 2) As per the University Ordinance No. 3, it is compulsory for all the students to appear in the physical efficiency test which is usually held in the month of January or February. Any failure on students' part shall invite disciplinary action.
- 3) All the students of the college are required to present themselves for a medical examination. Those failing to turn up for the test on the scheduled day will have to get themselves examined by paying a specified fine or else they may face disciplinary action.

□ N.S.S. □

The college N.S.S. unit comprises of 125 boys and 75 girls. It endeavours to instill a sense of social service and national integration in the volunteers. Apart from organising weekly and special camps, the college unit carries out several cultural and social activities.
