

## CAT DIFFICULT Test Solutions

**Q 1:**

Solution: (C) The important keywords in the given paragraph are – race relations, racial segregation and summer in the North. Only C statement captures these key words appropriately and the overall idea of the para. Other options misrepresent the facts.

**Q 2:**

Solution: (A) Important keywords in this paragraph are – The UN database, law enforcement, regulator tool, coercive tool etc. The first statement clearly describes the situation of the UN database and its potential. Other options either misrepresents the information or states the wrong facts.

**Q 3:**

Solution: (D) The important keywords are – Adiyogi, human well-being, scientific, significant. All these words together build a key concept. Only D option makes sense. Other options are close but they are misrepresented.

**Q 4:**

Solution: (B) The 4th sentence uses the pronoun which is used for the person called Trump in the 3rd sentence. Hence, 34 is a strong link here. Neither of the options except B uses this link. This makes 1234 the most logical sequence.

**Q 5:**

Solution: (A) The use of the conjunction besides in 2 hints that it will follow another sentence in sequence. 3 states a study about pet dogs, and 1 and 2 further elaborate that study. 4 defines the basis of that study in the end. 3214 is the most logical sequence here.

**Q 6:**

Solution: (C) 3 uses a pronoun 'He' in the beginning and 2 uses a proper noun 'Hitler' This provides a clear link between 2 and 3. Though 1 can never start the paragraph as it is more of a concluding sentence. The most logical sequence is 2341.

**Q 7:**

Solution: (D) 4 states a contrasting opinion to some previously stated idea and hence, cannot come in the beginning. 31 is a strong link chronologically. The only viable choice here is 2431.

**Q 8:**

Solution: (C) The paragraph seems to talk about the migrating habits of Asian and African elephants. 1, 2, and 4 are related as they talk about the same subject. Although 3 seems odd when discussing elephant's physical characteristics.

**Q 9:**

Solution: (D) Here, 1, 2, and 3 are clearly talking about linguistic features of a language. All of them are strongly linked to each other. On the other hand, 4 talks about a different subject. So, 4 is the odd one out here.

**Q 10:**

Solution: (C) All the given examples after the third blank are related to industrial activities. Hence, it can be assumed that the given sentence is related to the sentence followed by the third blank. It should be – “**Such earthquakes are related to industrial activities.** Some of the examples are mining, construction of water dams....”

**Q 11:**

Solution: (C) The given sentence introduces a fact. This means it will fit best in the 3rd blank because after it all the sentences are mainly focused on the IRS only. Hence, option 3 is correct.

**Q 12:**

Solution: (A) First paragraph last part will tell you why (A) is correct: “Nevertheless there are many aural histories, which give an insight into this unique poet and Saint of India.”

**Q 13:**

Solution: (C) It is correct as Mirabai’s new family never approved her piety and devotion to Krishna.

**Q 14:**

Solution: (B) As mentioned in the second para- “a wandering Sadhu came to her family’s home and gave a doll of Sri Krishna to her father”.

**Q 15:**

Solution: (A) As mentioned in the last paragraph that Mira often spend time discussing spiritual issues with Sadhus and people would join in the singing of her bhajans. This irked her in-laws more.

**Q 16:**

Solution: (B) The entire passage is about (B) specifically first, third and the last paragraphs. Whether (A) is true or not cannot be figured from the passage.

**Q 17:**

Solution: (B) Frederick said “I wanted to be the one to make a difference”. (Para – 4)

**Q 18:**

Solution: (C) It is not true because psychologists challenge the notion that one is inherently good or bad, stressing the role of environment as well.

**Q 19:**

Solution: (C) It is correct because the dual dispositional theory of morality states that good and evil both exist in an individual and that its expression in behaviour is dependent on both the environment and what one chooses. (Para 2)

**Q 20:**

Solution: (A) It is mentioned in the penultimate paragraph in the first two lines.
