Q 1: Solution: (B) Only B statement captures the main idea given in the paragraph without changing the

facts. D captures the idea but in the end it alters the given fact. A and C are far-fetched as per the given paragraph. **Q 2:** Solution: (A) Option A captures the key idea of the paragraph i.e. the

advancement and process

improvement in dairy industry. B is irrelevant and alters the fact. C deviates from the key idea

given in the para. D focuses mainly on automation. **Q 3:** Solution: (C) The C statement uses all the

important key ideas mentioned in the paragraph. It

rightfully describes the impact of the treaty on the Ottoman Empire. The A statement says the

Ottoman empire dictated peace which is incorrect. D statement is incorrect. B is close but it

misrepresents the information.

Q 4:

Solution: (B) 2 introduces the topic of silk. 3 defines a cause, and 4 provides a reason. 1 further elaborates both the 3 and 4 sentences. The logical sequence will be 2341.

Q 5:

Solution: (D) The use of the ordinals 'first' and 'second' confirms the link between 2 and 3. Hence, option A and C can never be correct. In option B, 2 comes before 3 which is also not possible. So, the correct sequence has to be 1324.

Q 6:

Solution: (B) 2 introduces the topic of air pollution. The keyword 'standards' creates a link between 3 and 1. Only, option C uses the link 231. Hence, the logical sequence is 2341.

Q 7:

Solution: (C) The sentences like 1, 2 and 4 are mainly associated with potential of water and memory of water. Only 3rd sentence talks about wastewater which is a different topic altogether. Hence, option 3 will be correct.

Q 8:

Solution: (A) The first sentence talks about proper medication. The other three are mainly associated with health technology and the author's view on that. Hence, 1 is the odd one out here.
